FOR VISION AND FAITH

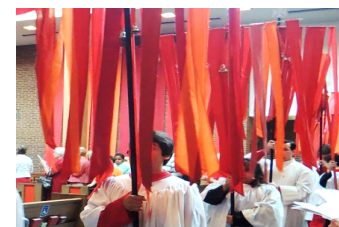
